Recommendation:

Adopt resolution adopting the Yuba County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Background:

The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires hazard mitigation planning as part of the Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act. In June of 2004, the County of Yuba received a planning grant through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program (PDM). The Yuba County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan was submitted to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Service (State OES) and FEMA. On August 24 2007, FEMA completed review of the Yuba County Plan and determined the Plan is eligible for final approval pending formal adoption by Yuba County and its participating jurisdictions.

Discussion:

The Yuba County Plan has been approved by FEMA, pending formal adoption by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors. A condition of the grant awarded to the County is the completion of a Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. The adoption of the County Plan will comply with this requirement of DMA 2000

Twenty-nine jurisdictions and agencies will be adopting the Yuba County Plan and annexes to fulfill DMA 2000 requirements for multi-jurisdictional planning and the Yuba County PDM grant. Adoption of the County Plan and annexes will be forwarded to FEMA upon receipt.

Committee Action: This matter is being presented directly to the Board of Supervisors.

Financial Impact:

The Yuba County Hazard Mitigation Project is funded by a FEMA PDM grant. Adoption of the Yuba County Plan will enable the County to continue to receive certain federal grant funds.
