RE: CONTRACT WITH DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS
FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW INBOARD MOTOR AND DIVE
EQUIPMENT

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the contract between the California Department of Boating and Waterways and the County of Yuba for the purchase of a new boat motor, and specialized dive equipment.

BACKGROUND:

In 2001, the Department of Boating and Waterways funded the purchase of a Thunder Jet Patrol Boat, powered by a 2001 Yamaha Z150 engine. The Engine is now in need of being rebuilt or replaced. The Department of Boating and Waterways (DBW) is currently offering State-administered Federal grant in the amount of \$14,300 that will be used to replace the boat motor, and purchase additional dive equipment for use in the Sheriff's Boating and Safety Enforcement Program. A copy of the contract is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

DISCUSSION:

The motor to be purchased will replace a 2001 Yamaha Z150 engine. The State Fleet Inspector has determined that the motor is not worth replacing, due to its age and condition. Under the grant rules, this equipment would be used by the Sheriff's Department, but legally owned by the Department of Boating and Waterways. The motor is estimated at \$13,000, and the balance of the funds will be used to purchase specialized dive equipment, including an OTS full face mask with communication system, wet suit, and fins.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact to the general fund. The grant will provide the County with \$14,300 to purchase the motor and dive equipment. Though the State keeps title to the equipment, the Sheriff's Department may operate it for its useful life.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

The item was presented at the Law and Justice Committee on January 8, 2008, and is recommended to the full Board for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Affirms Yuba County's intent to purchase a new boat and trailer for use in the Boating Safety and Enforcement Aid Program with said Federal funds, and, to abide by the terms set forth in the funding contract.
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board, subject to the approval of County Counsel, to sign the Boating Safety and Enforcement Grant Equipment and Operation Contract with the State as well as any future amendments thereto.


